

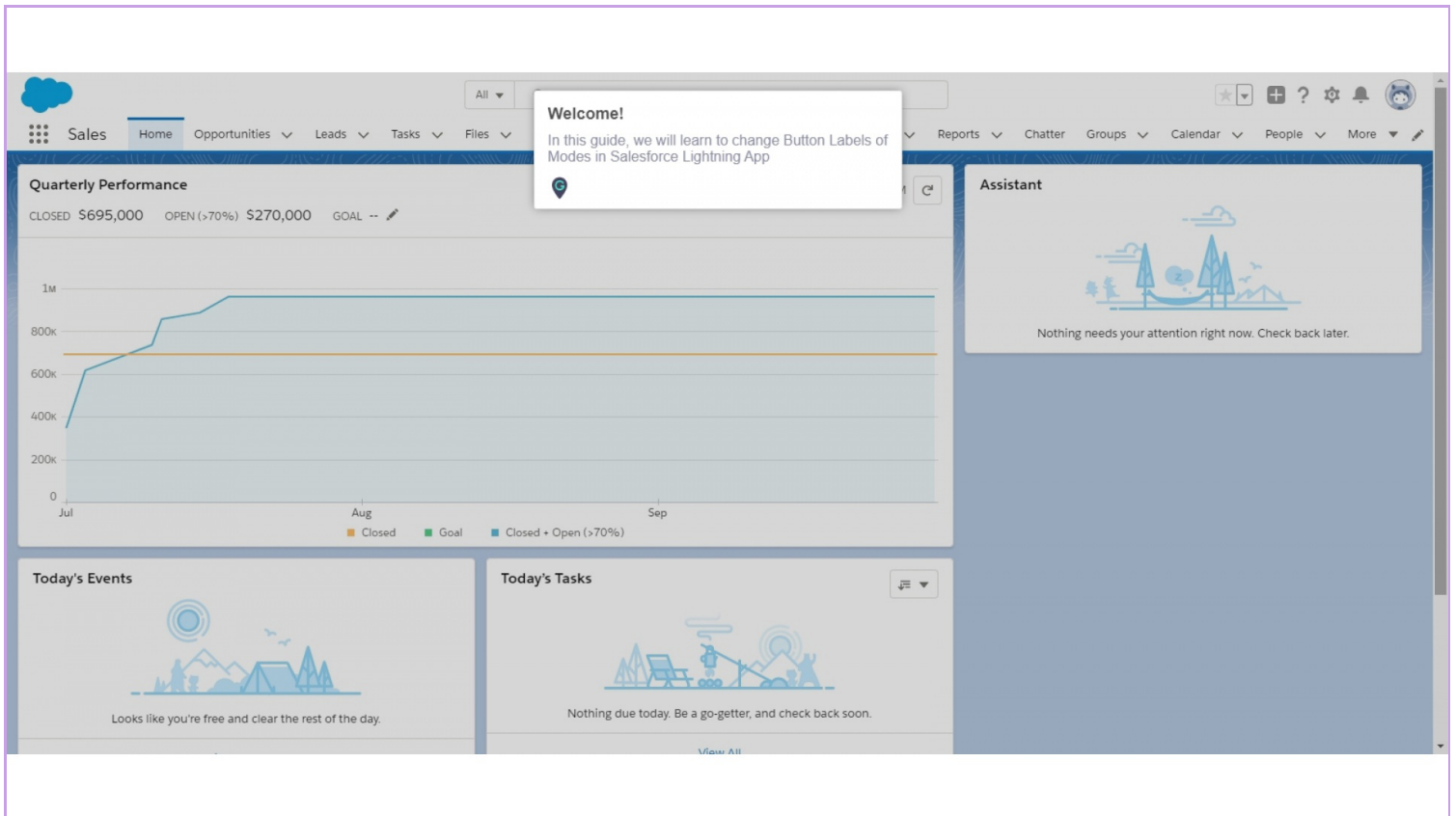

In this guide, we will learn to change Button Labels of Modes in Salesforce Lightning App



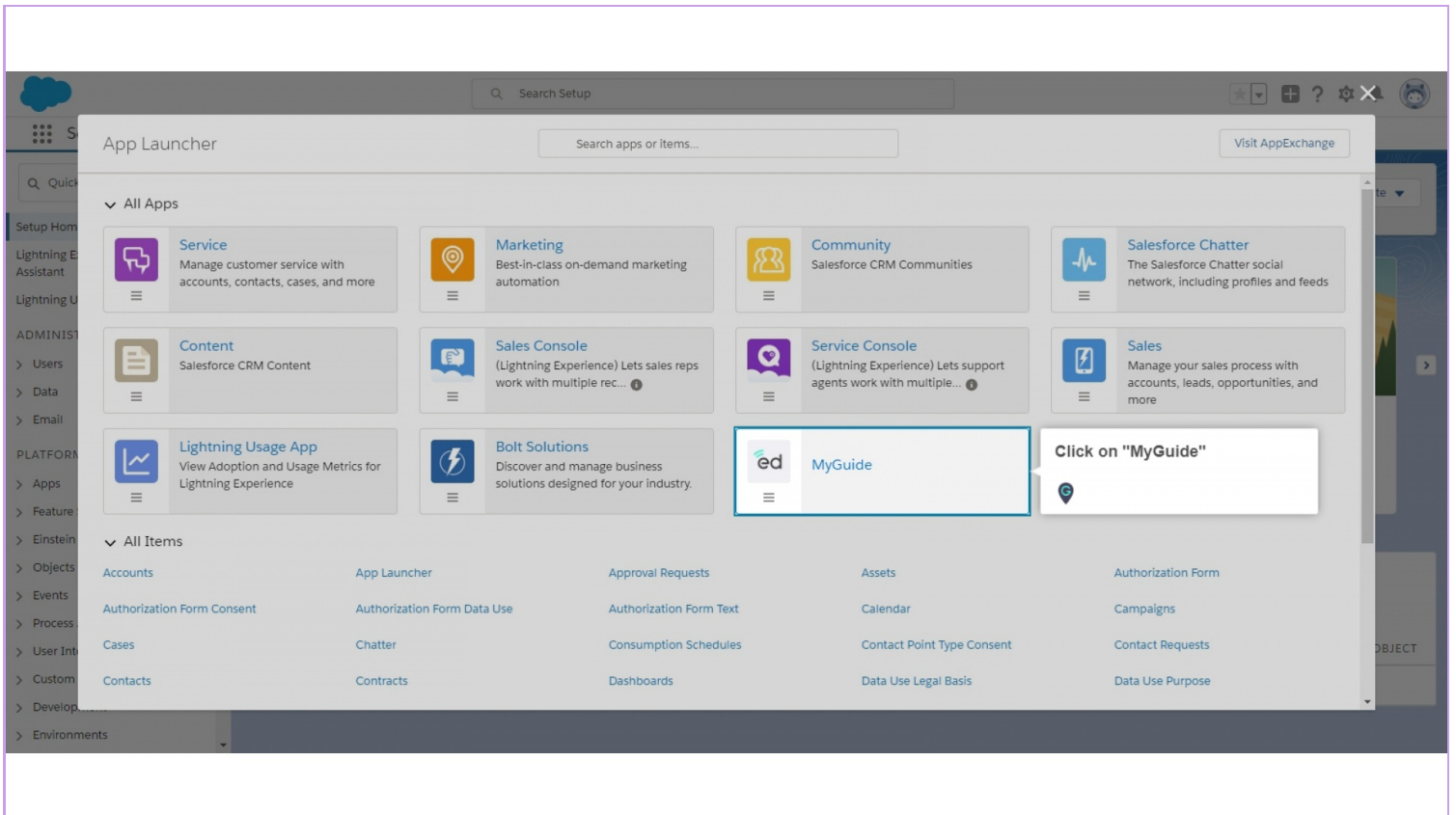
Step: 02



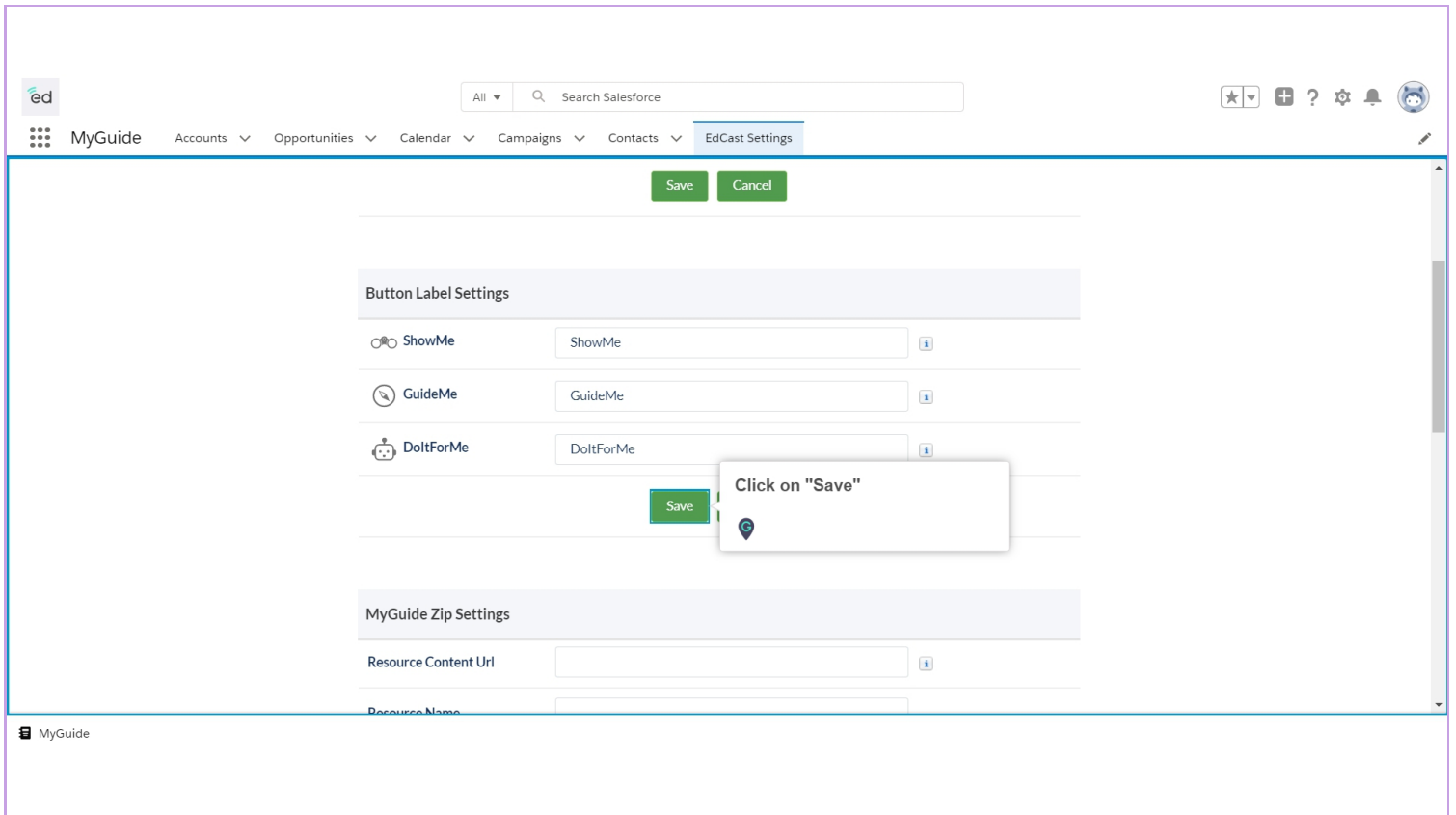


