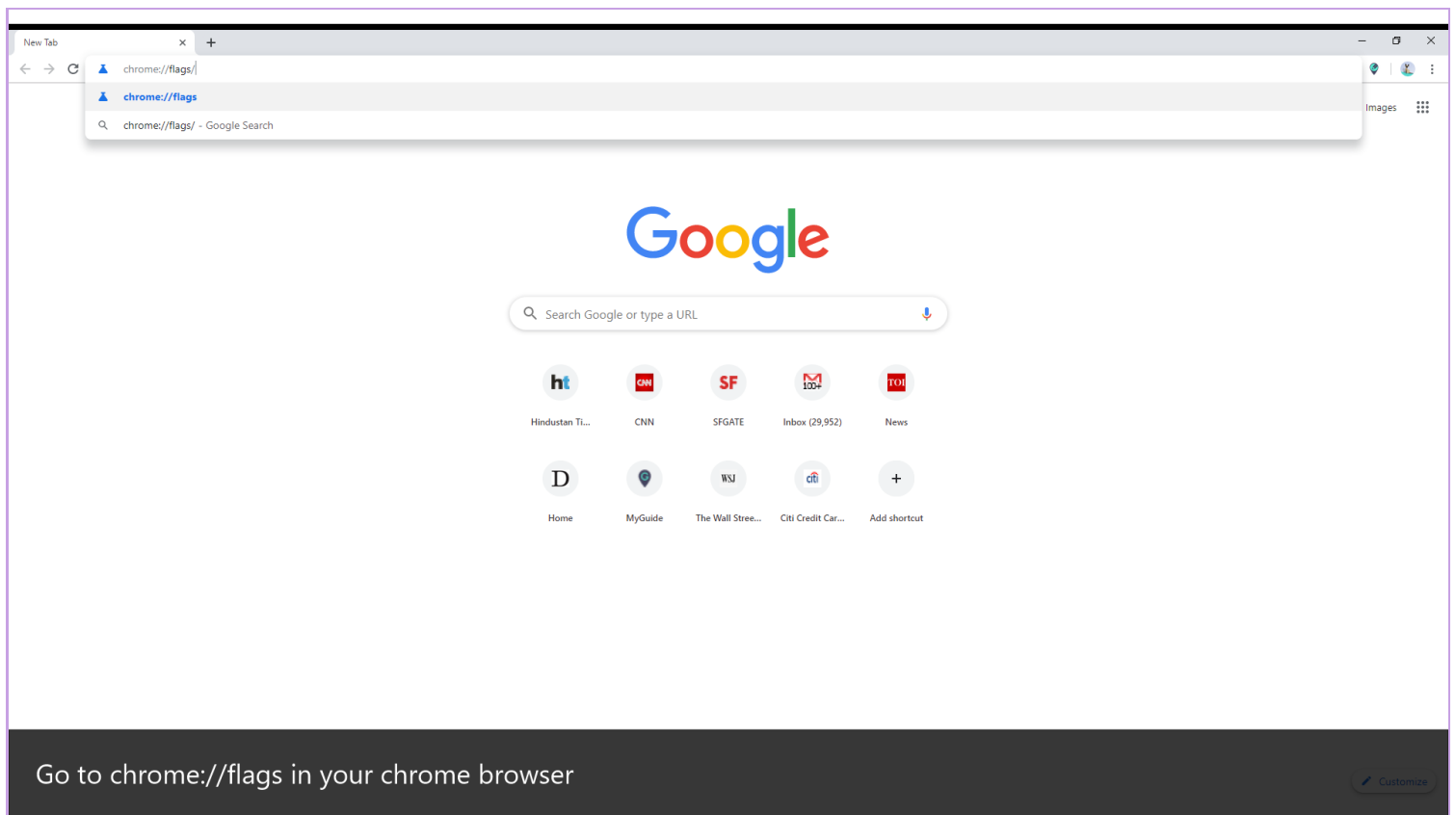




How to fix extension corruption problem with
chrome flags

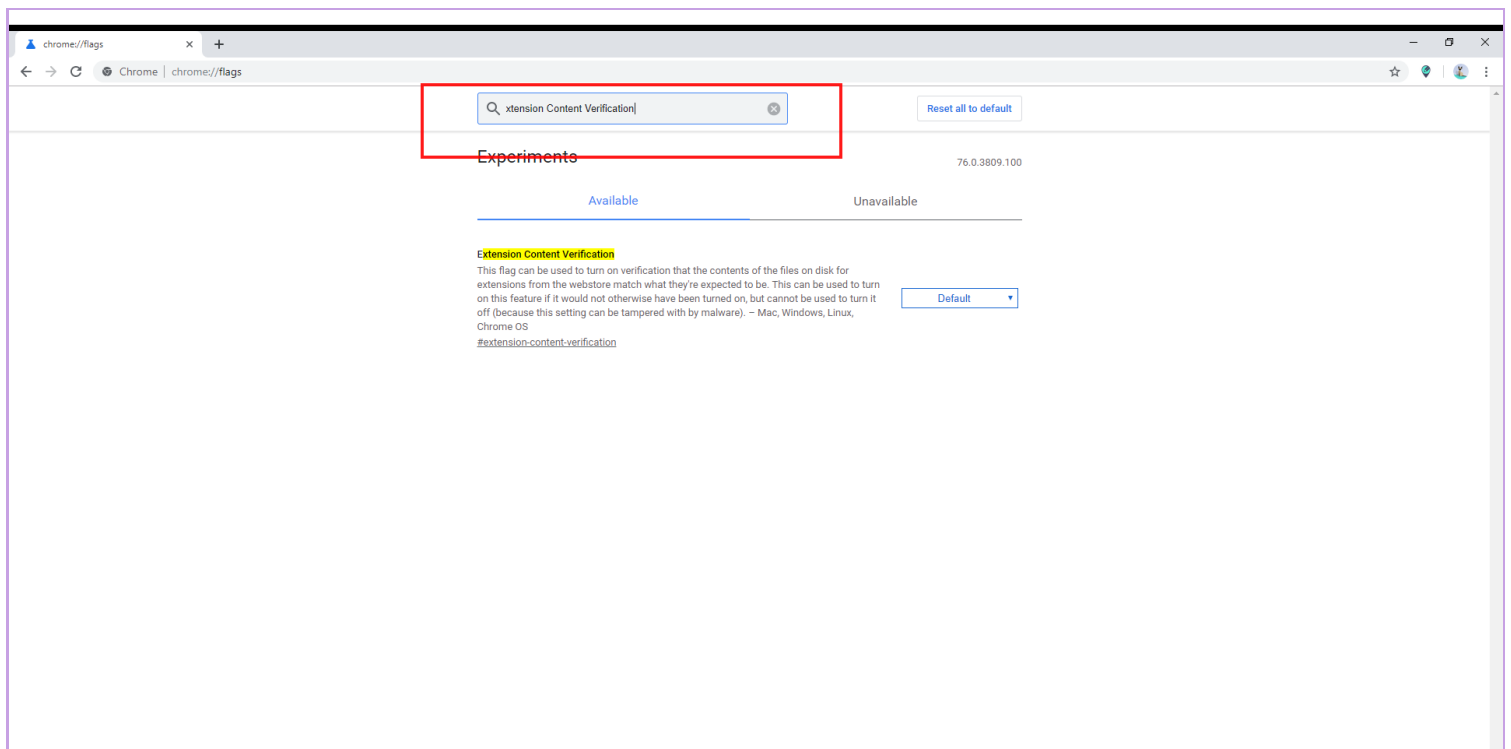
Step: 01

Go to `chrome://flags` in your chrome browser



Step: 02


Type extension content verification in search window
