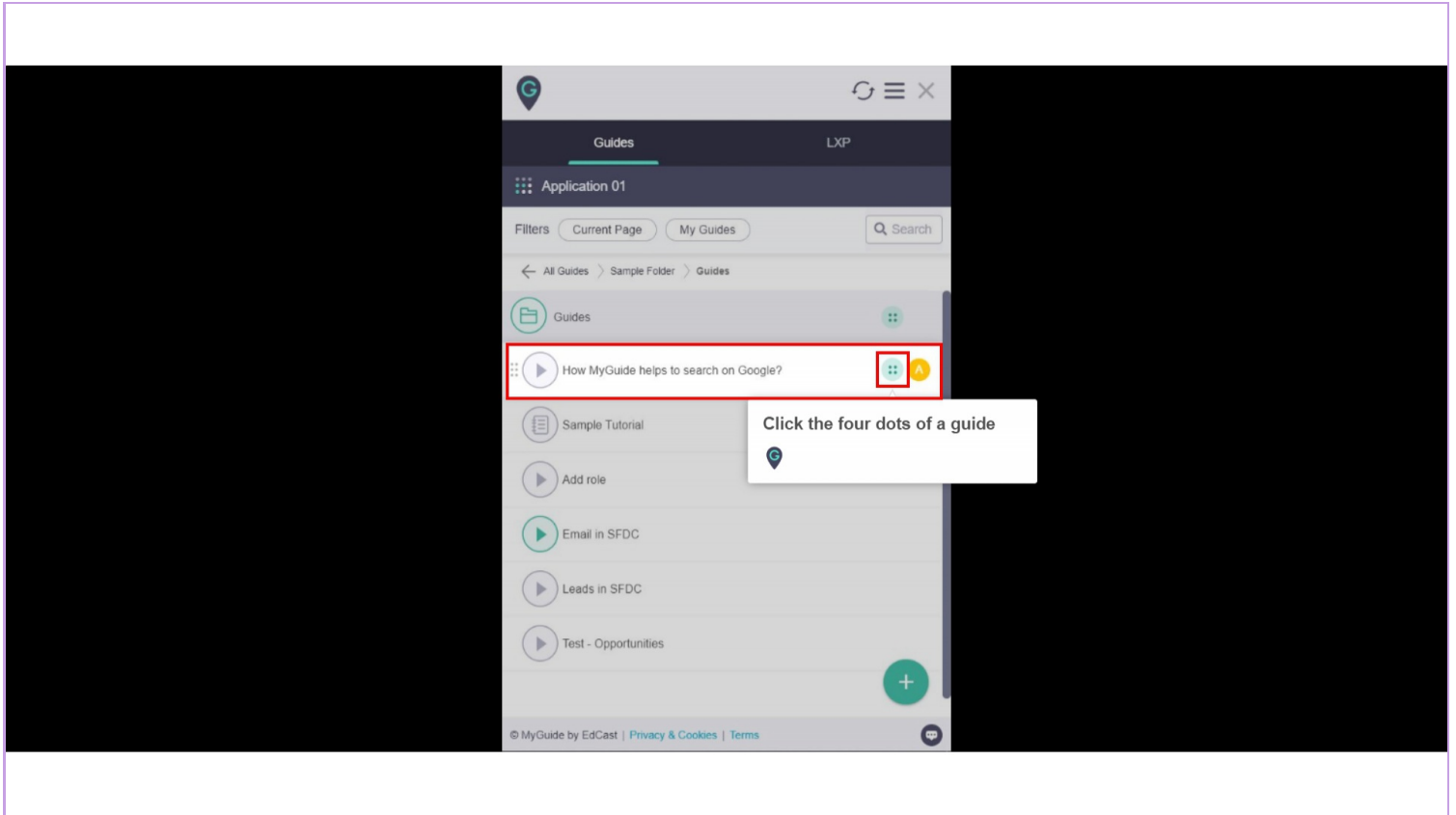

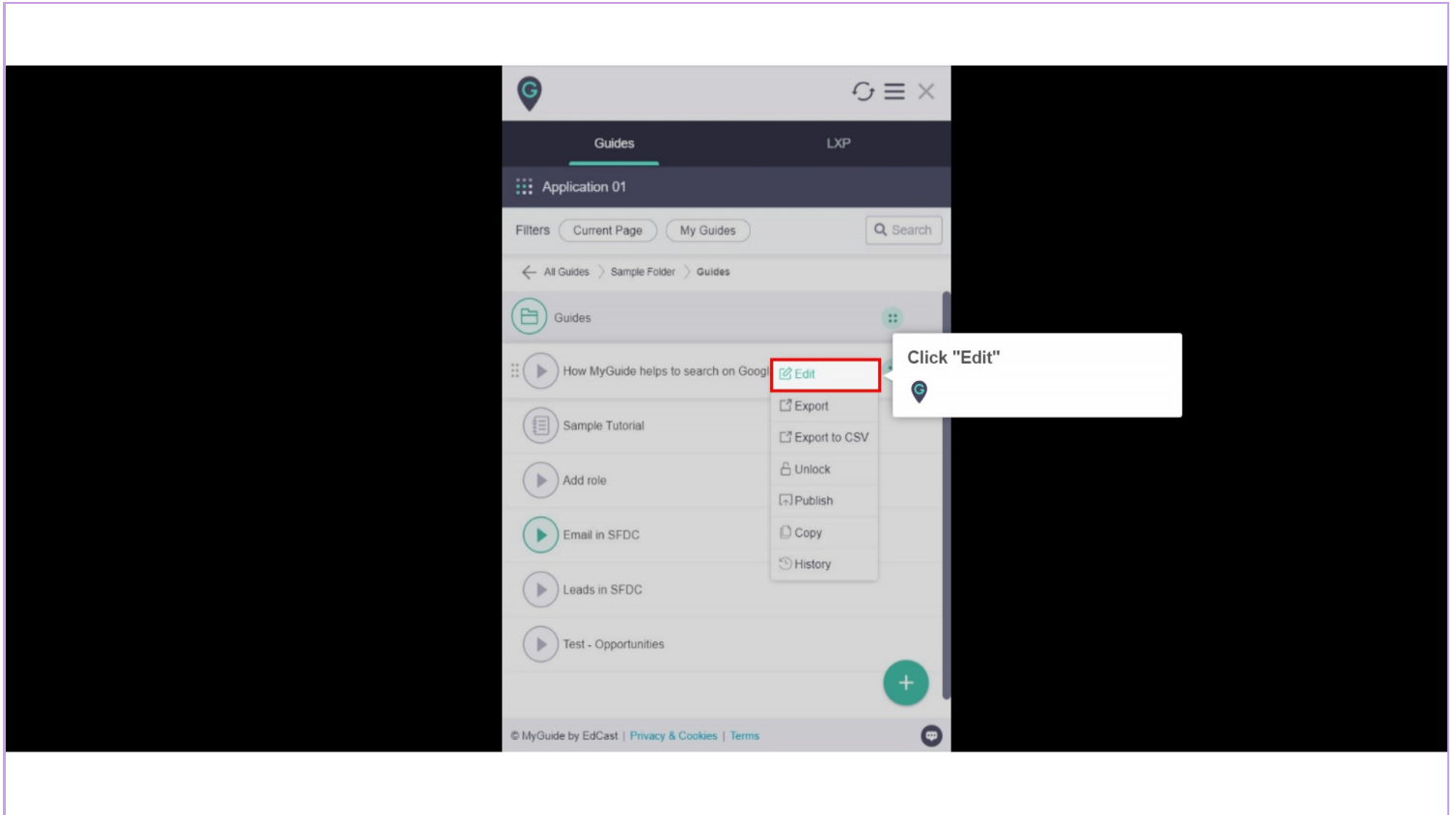
Step: 01

Click the four dots of a guide




Step: 02

Click here to expand the "Advanced Settings" section

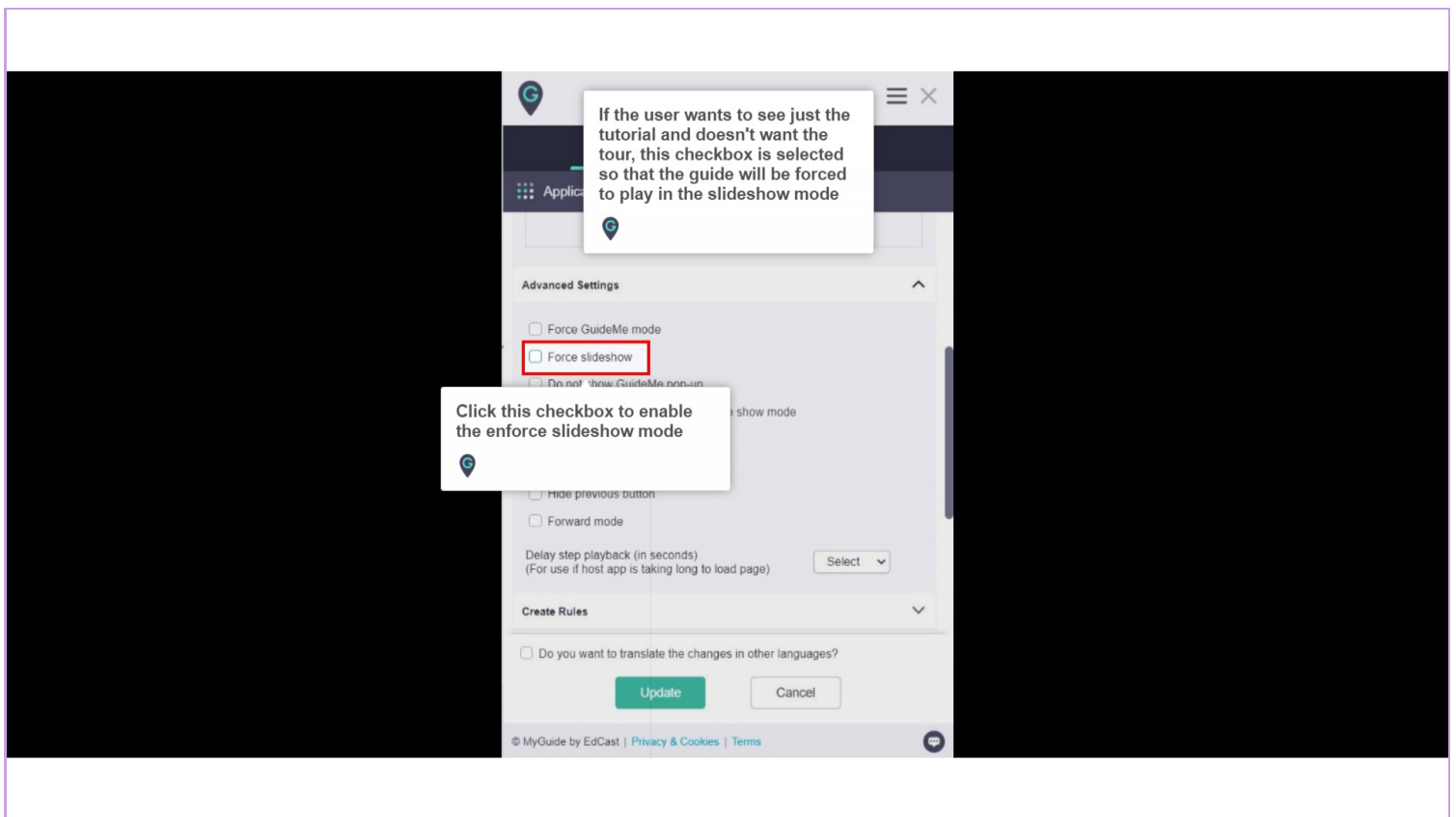

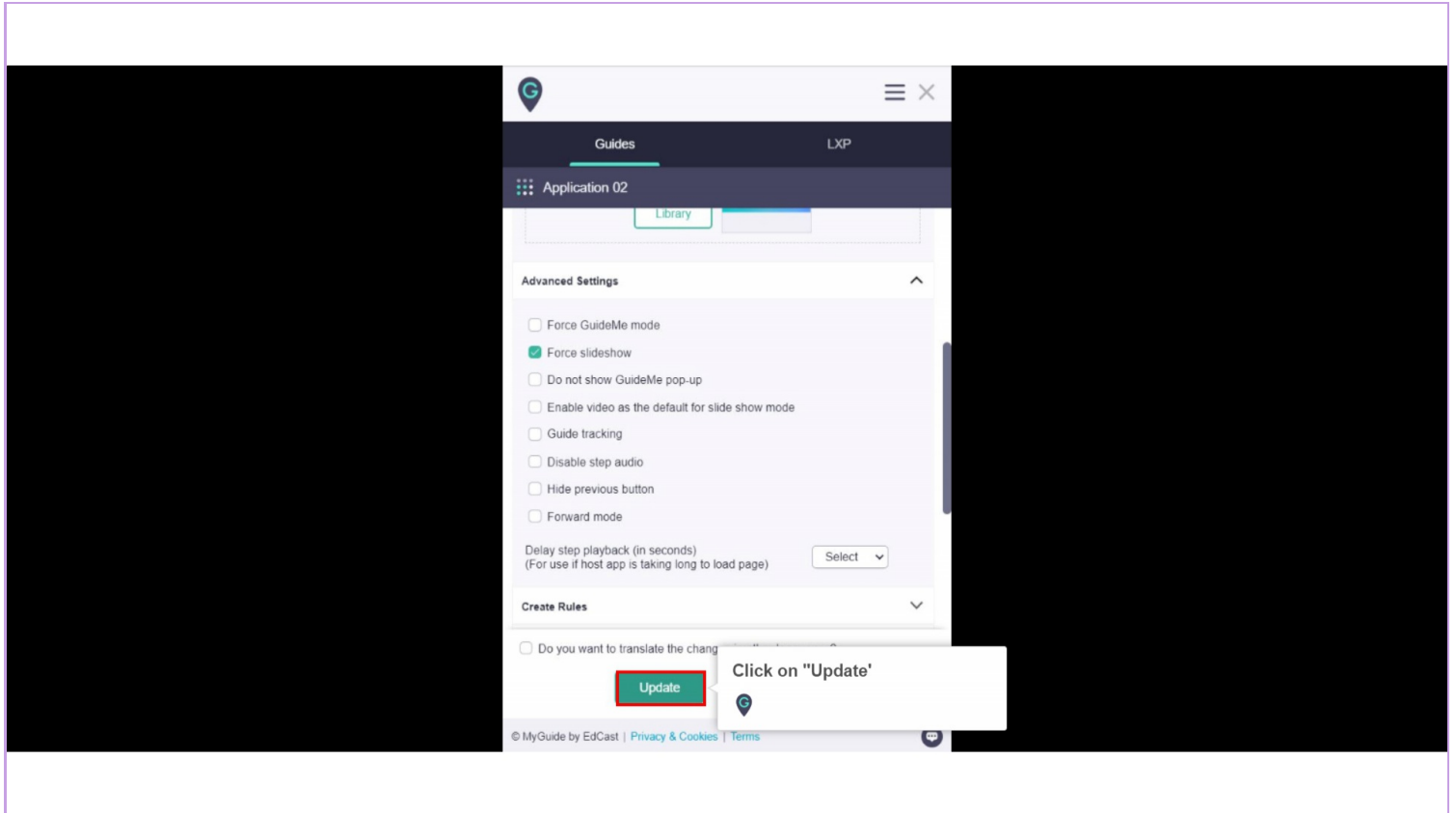
If the user wants to see just the tutorial and doesn't want the tour, this checkbox is selected so that the guide will be forced to play in the slideshow mode

Click this checkbox to enable the enforce slideshow mode



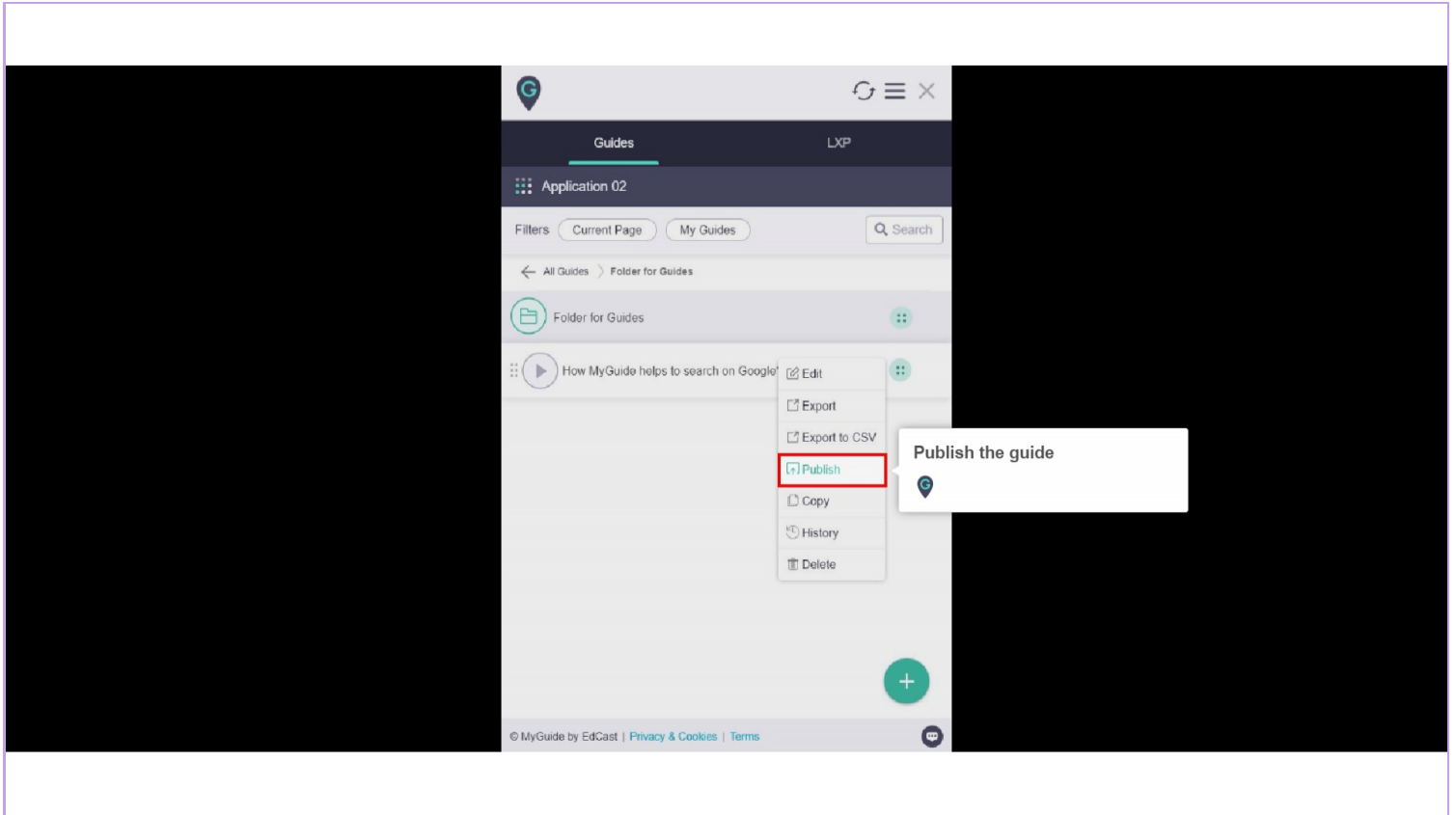
Step: 05

Click on "Update"



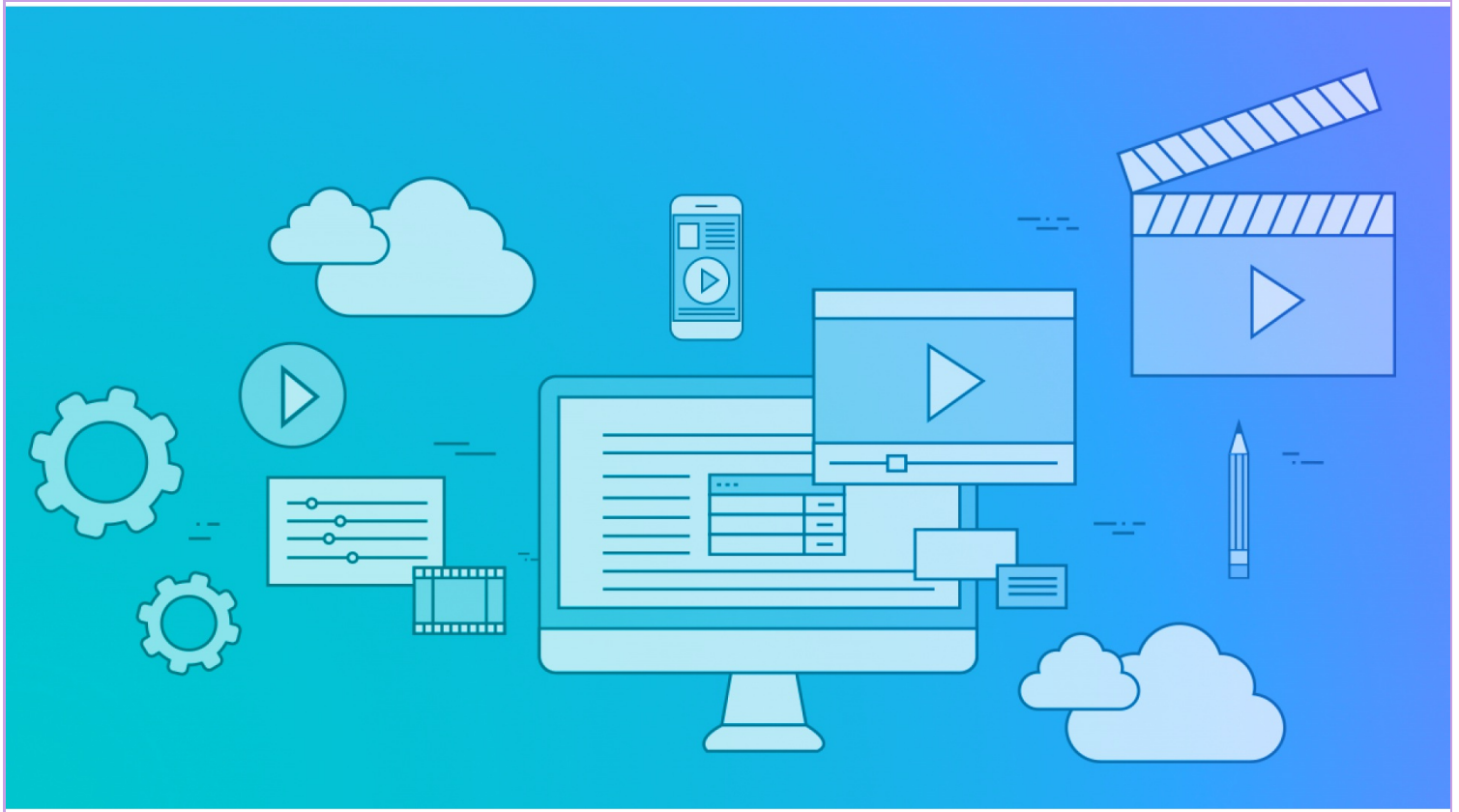
Step: 06
