




Forward mode

Step: 01


Forward mode is used to reduce the number of clicks as it runs the in-app guide automatically

For this, we need to enable the option from Organization Settings, then every step will show a forward button while playing




Step: 02

If we want to keep this option disabled in some guides of any folder, we will have to disable it from guide level settings individually




Step: 03

Click the four dots of a guide




Step: 04




Step: 06

Click on "Update"




Step: 07

Publish the guide




Step: 08
