




How to Add a Beacon to Push a Workflow Guide


Step: 01

Click on four dots




Step: 02

Click on "Edit"




Step: 03

Inside Guide settings, click on "Beacon"




Step: 04

Click on "Select Beacon"




Step: 05

Select an element where you want the beacon to be




Step: 06







Click on "Update" to save settings




Step: 17

Click on "Publish"




Step: 18
