




How to Add Opacity

Step: 01

Opacity highlights the step element by partially hiding the rest of the page, it captures the user's attention to the focused element


All you have to do is, drag the "Screen Opacity" toggle towards left or right

Left is the lightest at "0"




Step: 02

This is a medium shade!



Step: 03

The extreme right is the darkest at "10"
