




## How to Control Opacity of a Step


## Step: 01

Click on "Add Step"




## Step: 02

You are in Capture mode, select an element to open creator panel




## Step: 04


Here, you can add or change step title and description



## Step: 06


Opacity scale varies from 0 to 10.

Here, screen opacity is zero




## Step: 07
