




How to install Chrome extension using
PowerShell Script

Step: 01


Powershell script can be used to perform bulk installation of MyGuide Chrome extensions on a group of computers with a few lines of code


Click on "Download"


Click on "Free MyGuide Creator, Player and Automator"



Step: 04


In the above case, the ID is - lbhpijbhnnpcobofdieiocbphkdjjbef

Step: 05


Next, download the Powershell script file to your machine


Open PowerShell in Administrator mode



Step: 07


Run the below command in PowerShell

```
.\New-ChromeExtension.ps1 -Extension 'lbhpijbhnnpcobofdieiocbphkdjjbef' -Hive Machine
```



Step: 08


This will be the output from the above step



Step: 09

Installed by your administrator means the users won't be able to remove the extension manually

When the Chrome starts next time, MyGuide extension will be installed in the background
