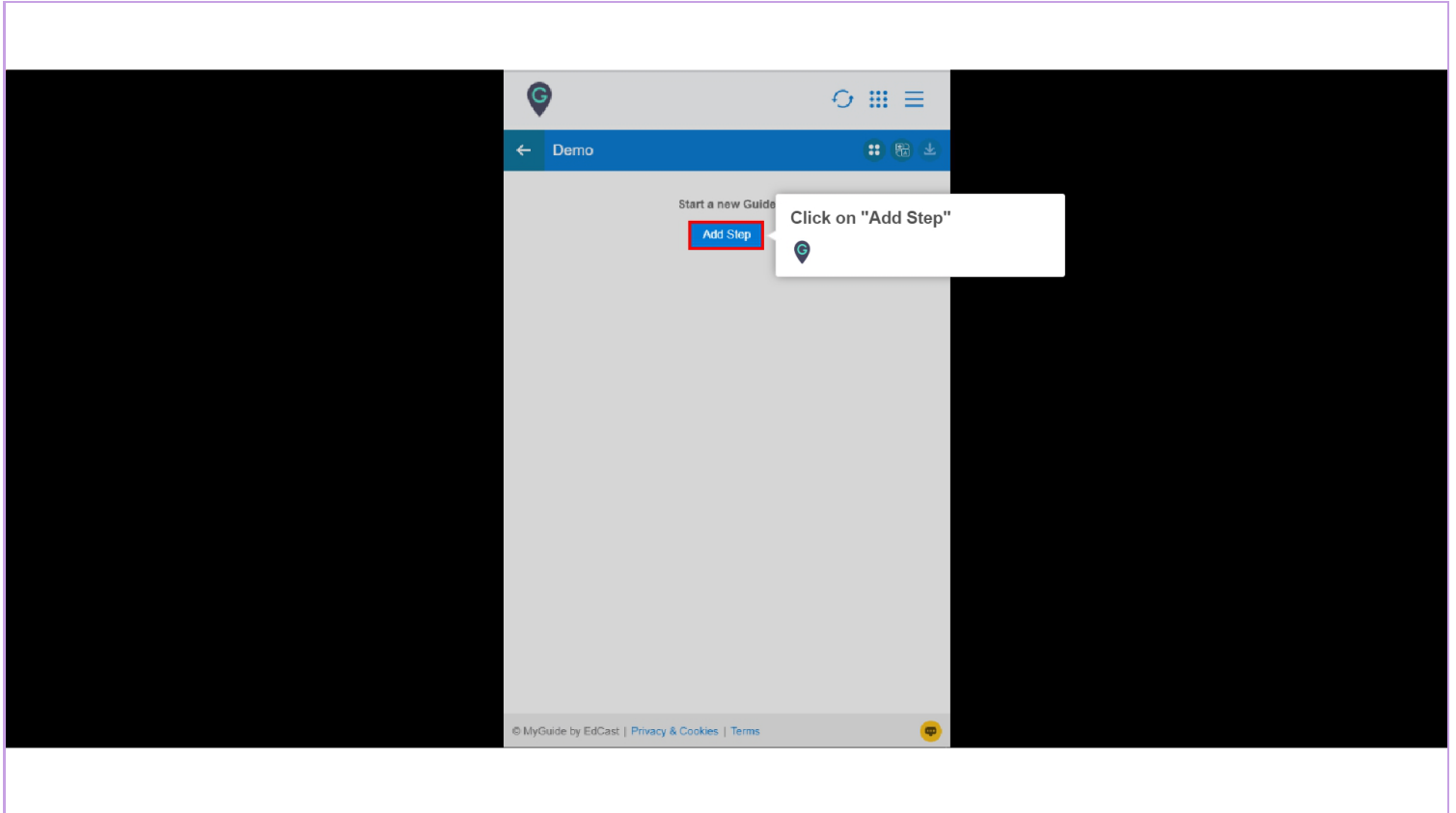




## How to Mark a Step as Optional

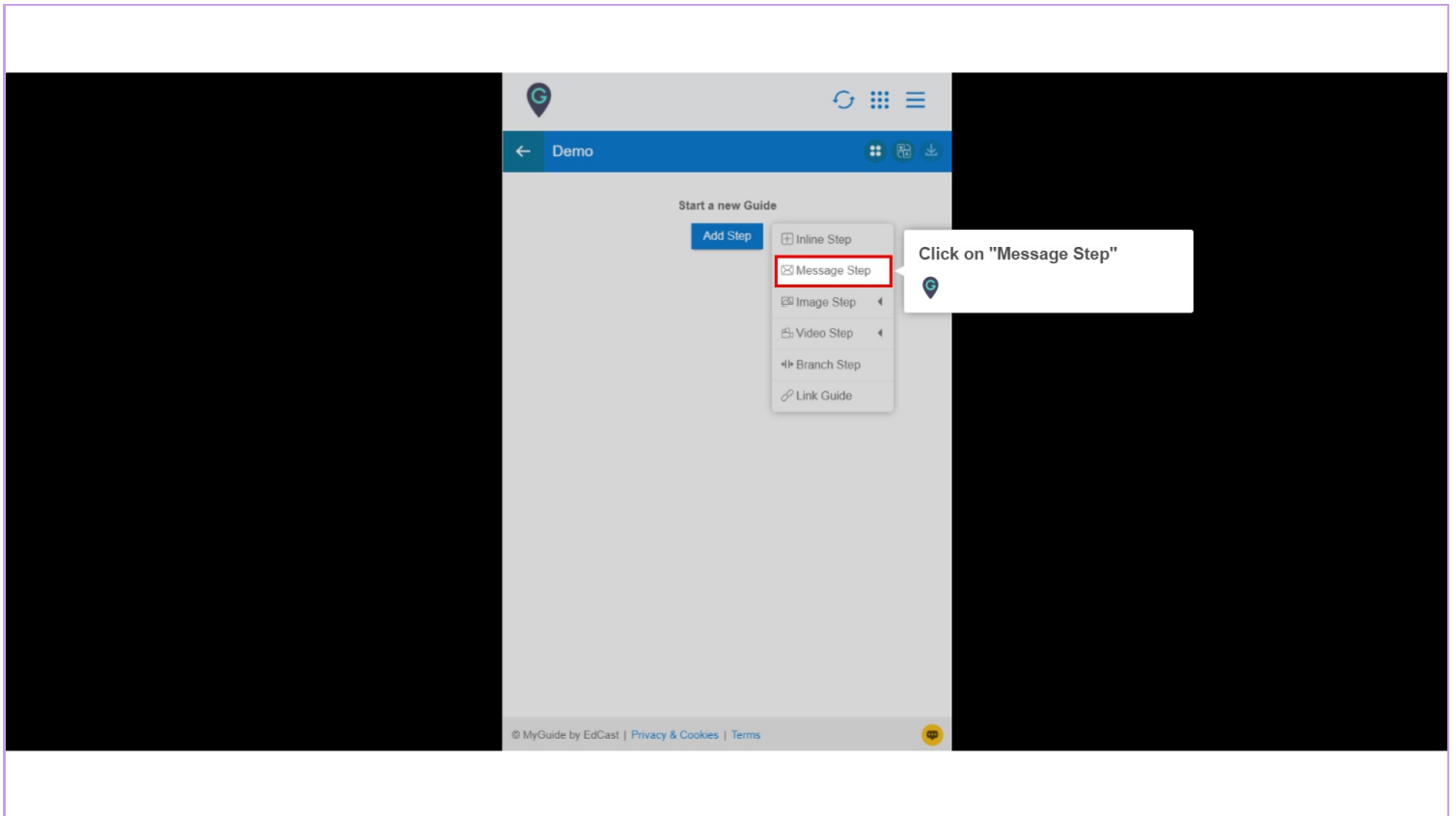
# Step: 01

Click on "Add Step"



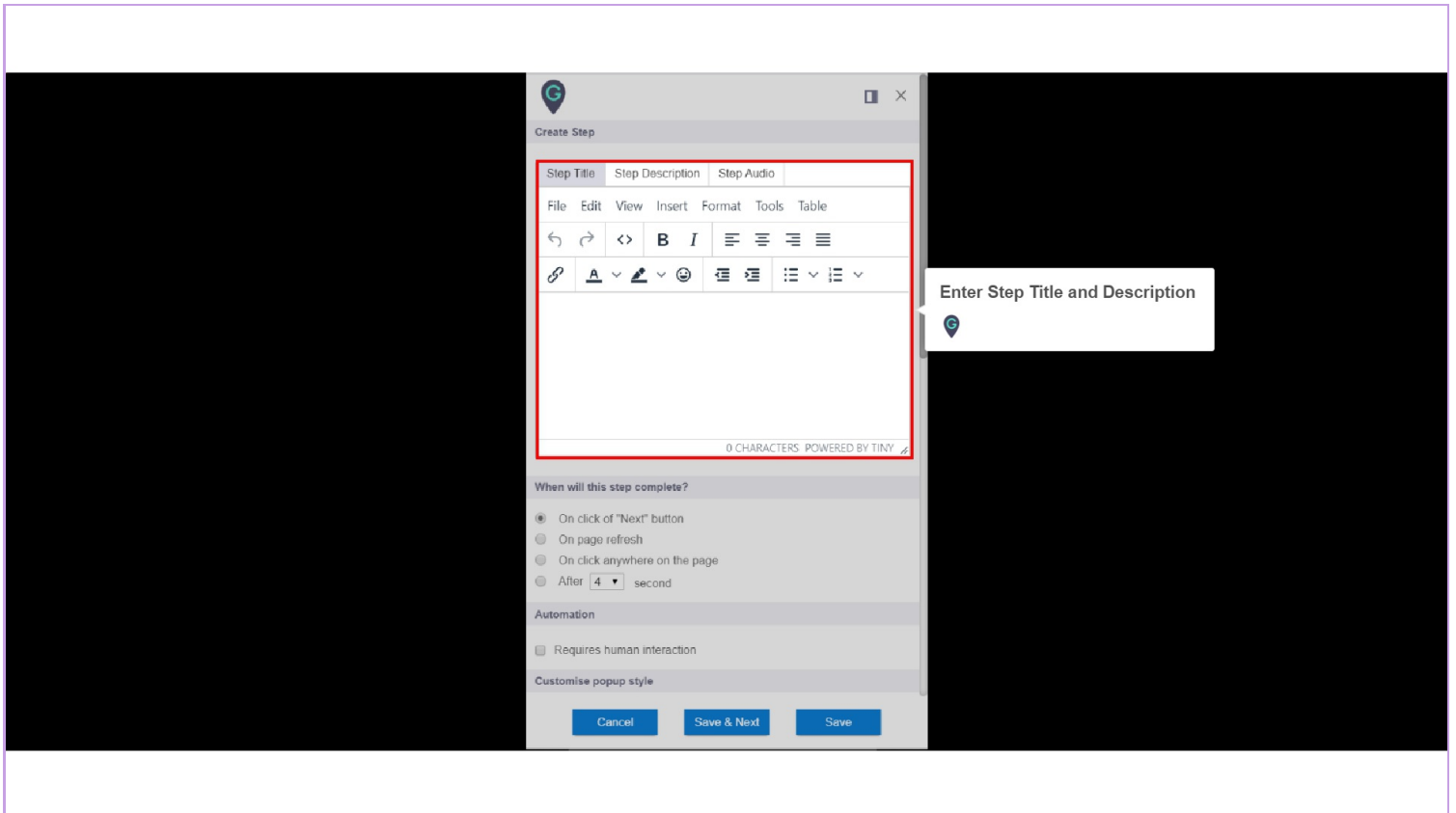
## Step: 02

Click on "Message Step"



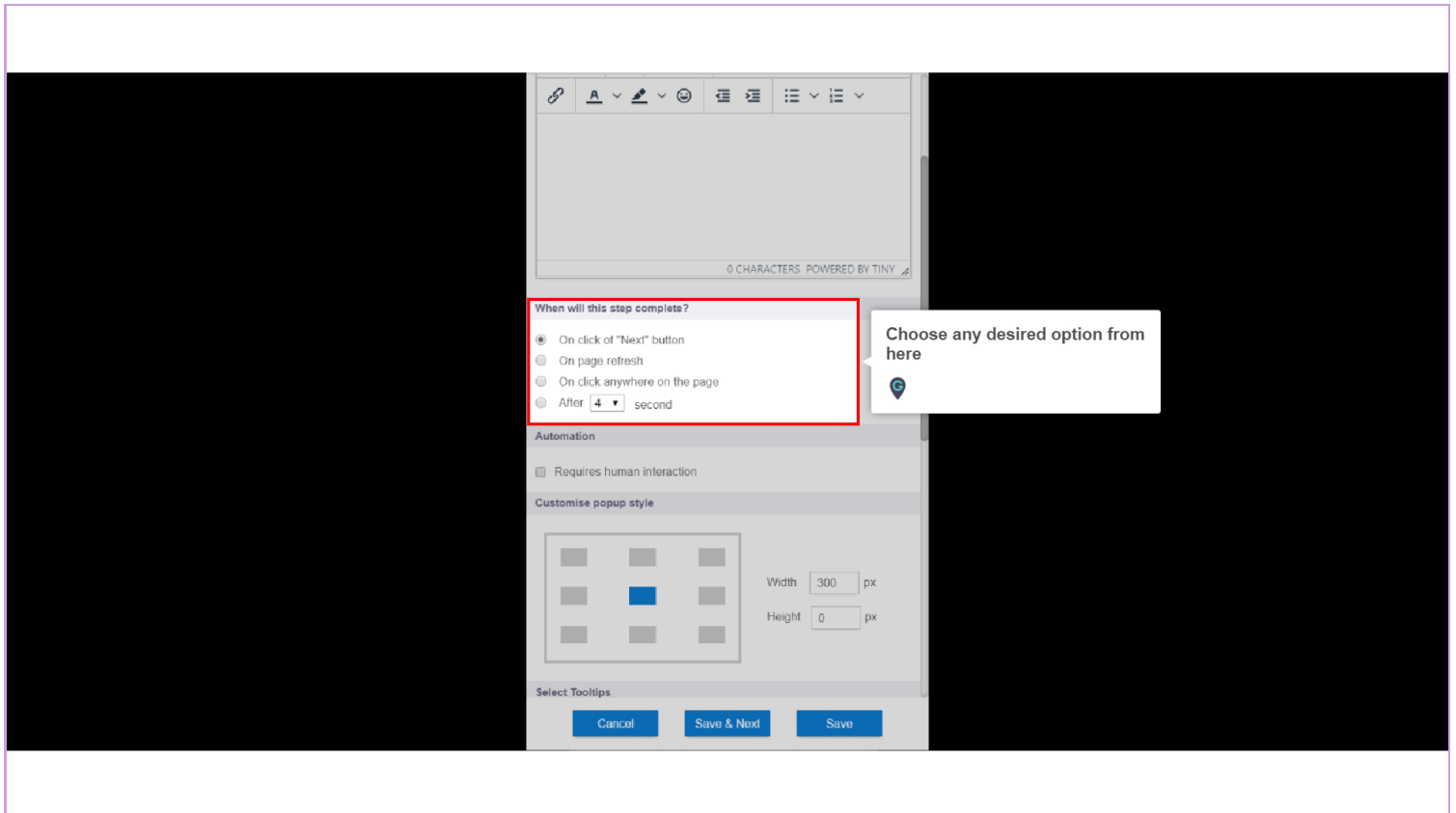
## Step: 03

Enter Step Title and Description



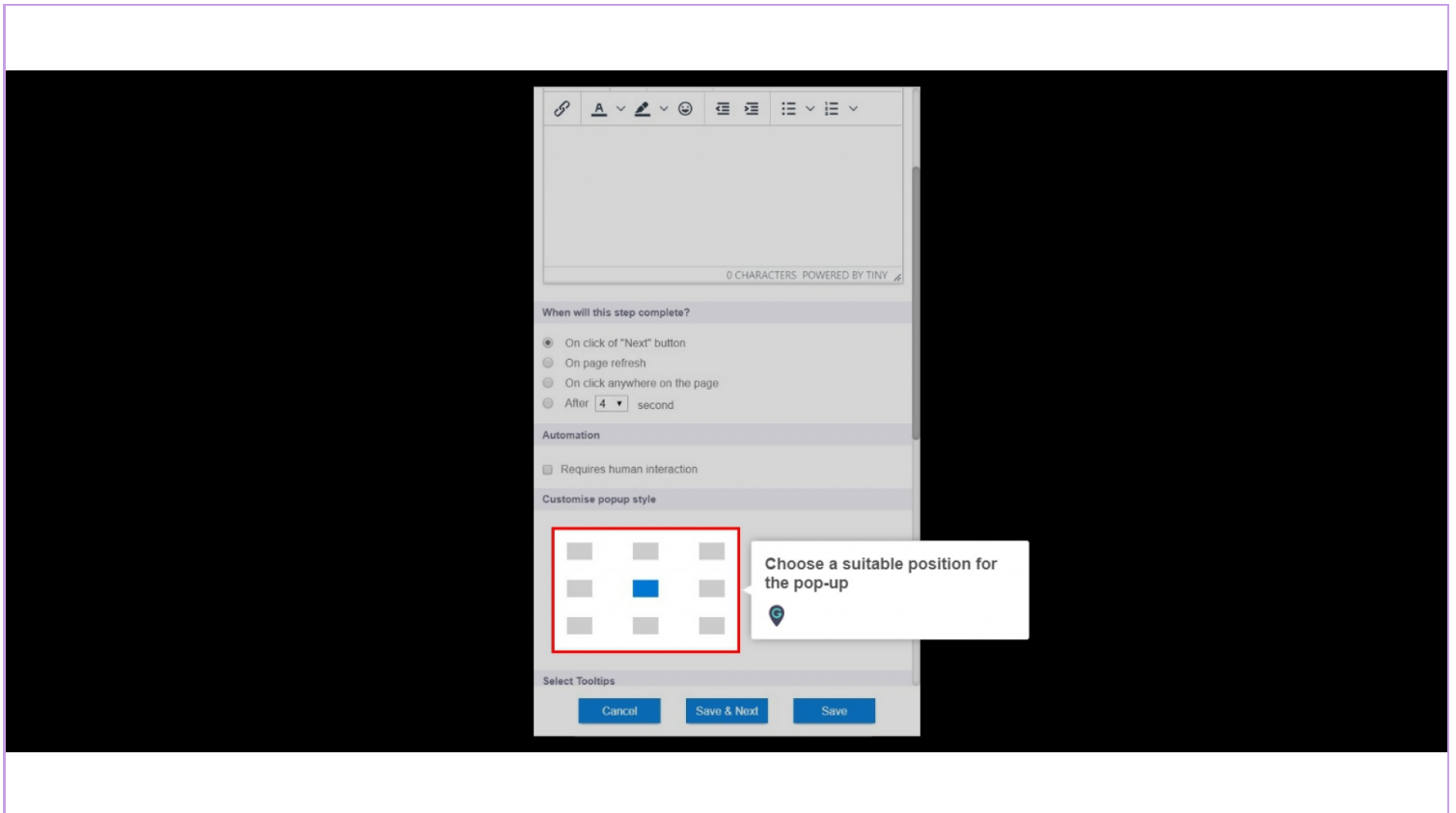
## Step: 04

Choose any desired option from here




## Step: 05

## Step: 06

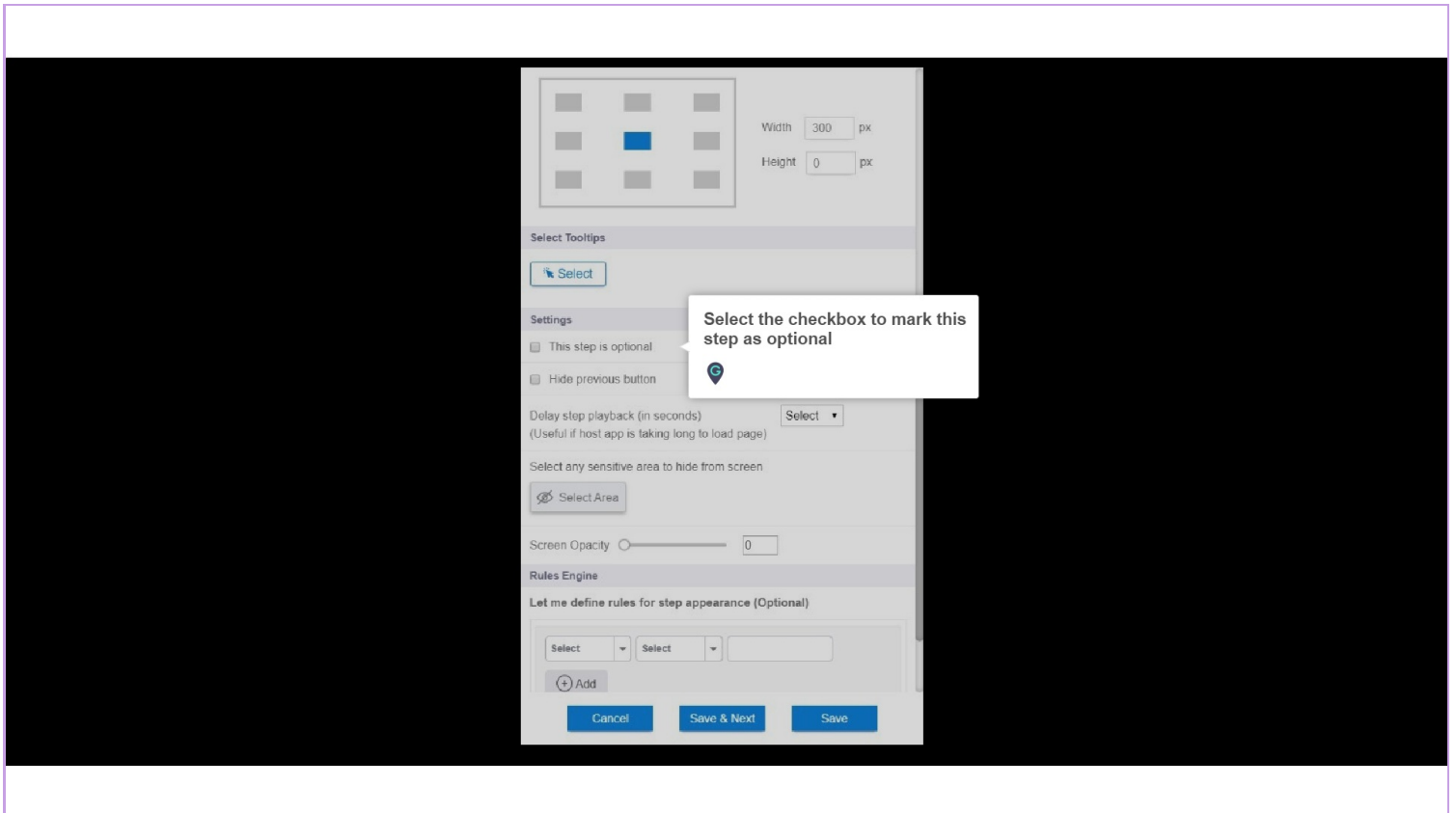
Set Width and Height for the pop-up

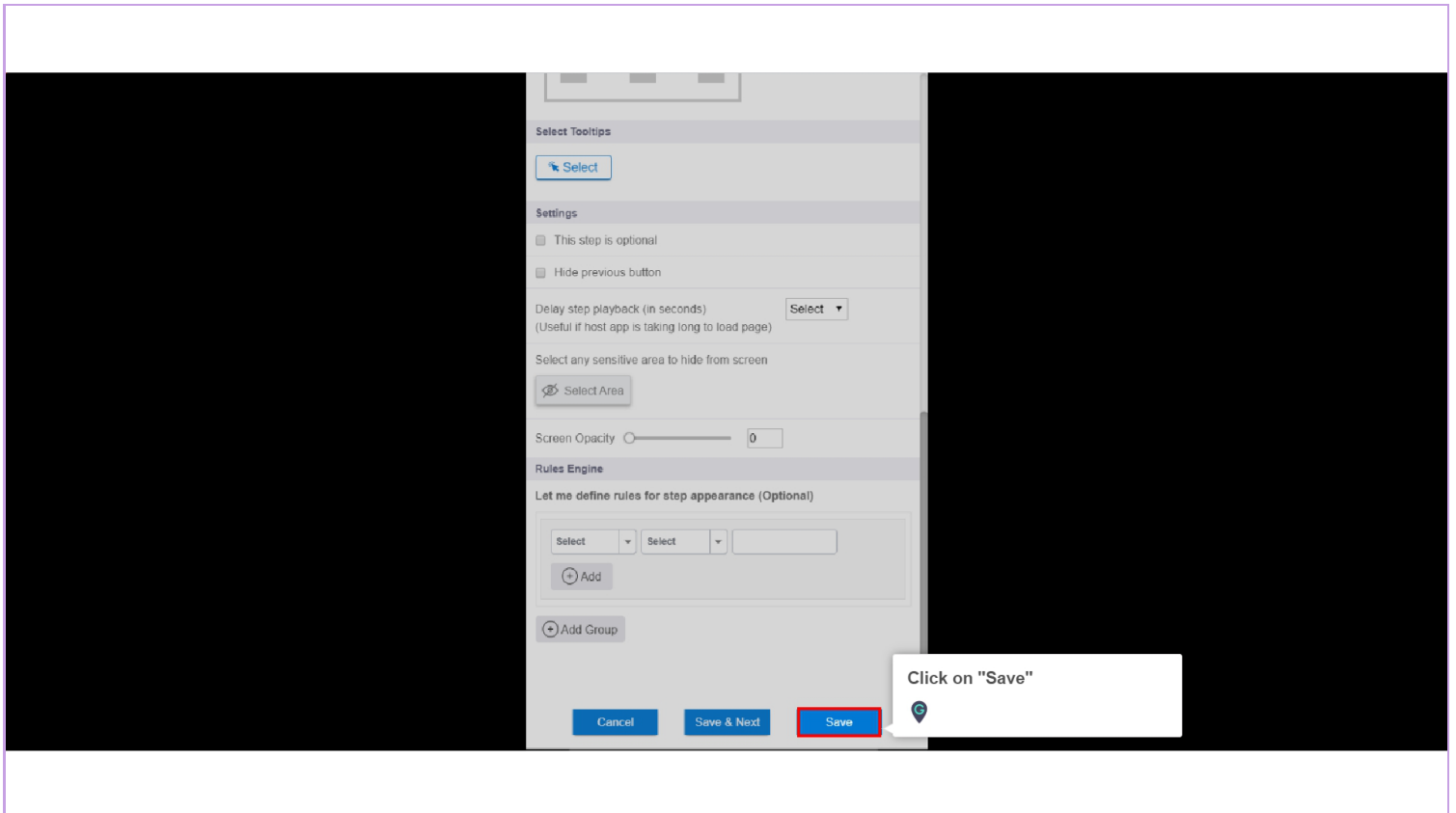
Select the checkbox to mark this step as optional
