




## How to Use Regex


# Step: 01

Click on the "+" icon




## Step: 02

## Step: 03


Enter a name for the Tooltip



Add a Rule




## Step: 05

Click on "Submit"




## Step: 06

Click on "Add Step"




## Step: 07

Select "Validation"




## Step: 08

## Step: 09


Select "Validation type" from here

Regular expressions (shortened as "regex") are special strings representing a pattern to be matched in a search operation






## Step: 11

Enter the regex and a message for sake of displaying on tooltip and save it




## Step: 12
