




How to use the Power HTML option as a Tooltip Guide


Step: 01

Click on "+" icon




Step: 02

Step: 03


Enter a name for the tooltip





Click on "Submit"








Step: 11

Click on "Publish Icon"




Step: 12

Step: 13


Ensure that the parent folder is published where you have created the tooltip guide
