

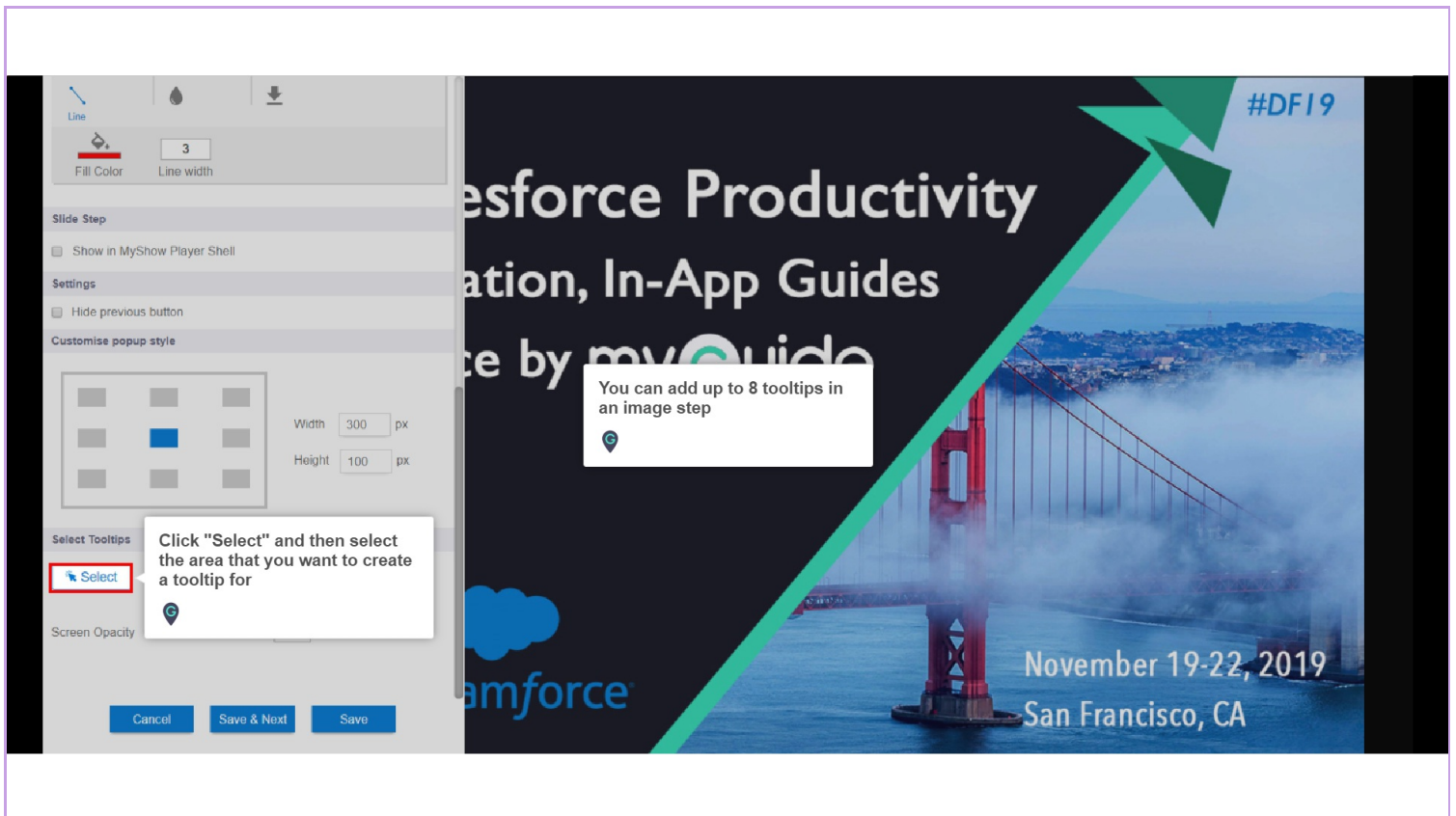


How to Use Tooltips in Image Steps

Step: 01

You can add up to 8 tooltips in an image step

Click "Select" and then select the area that you want to create a tooltip for



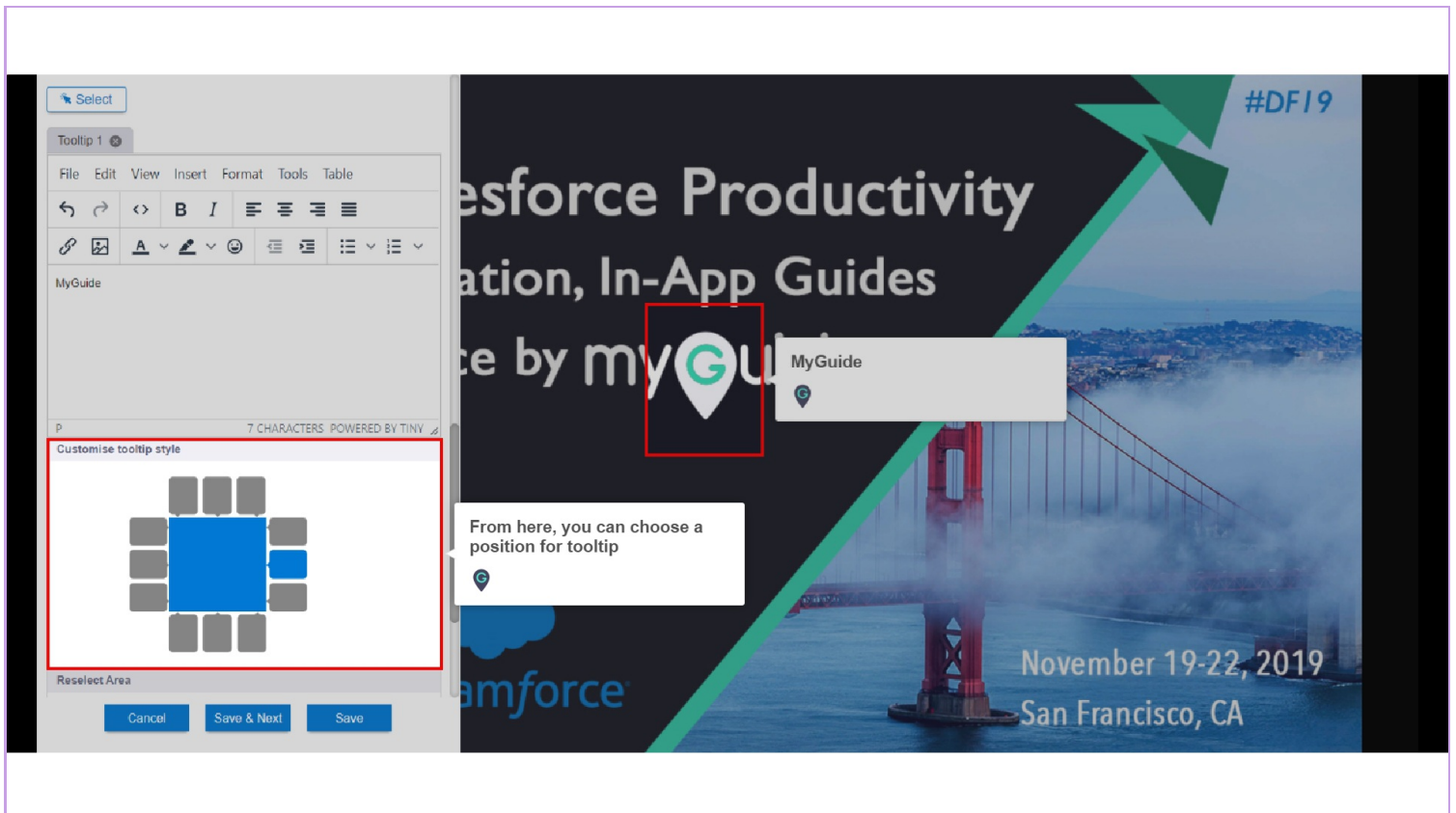
Step: 02

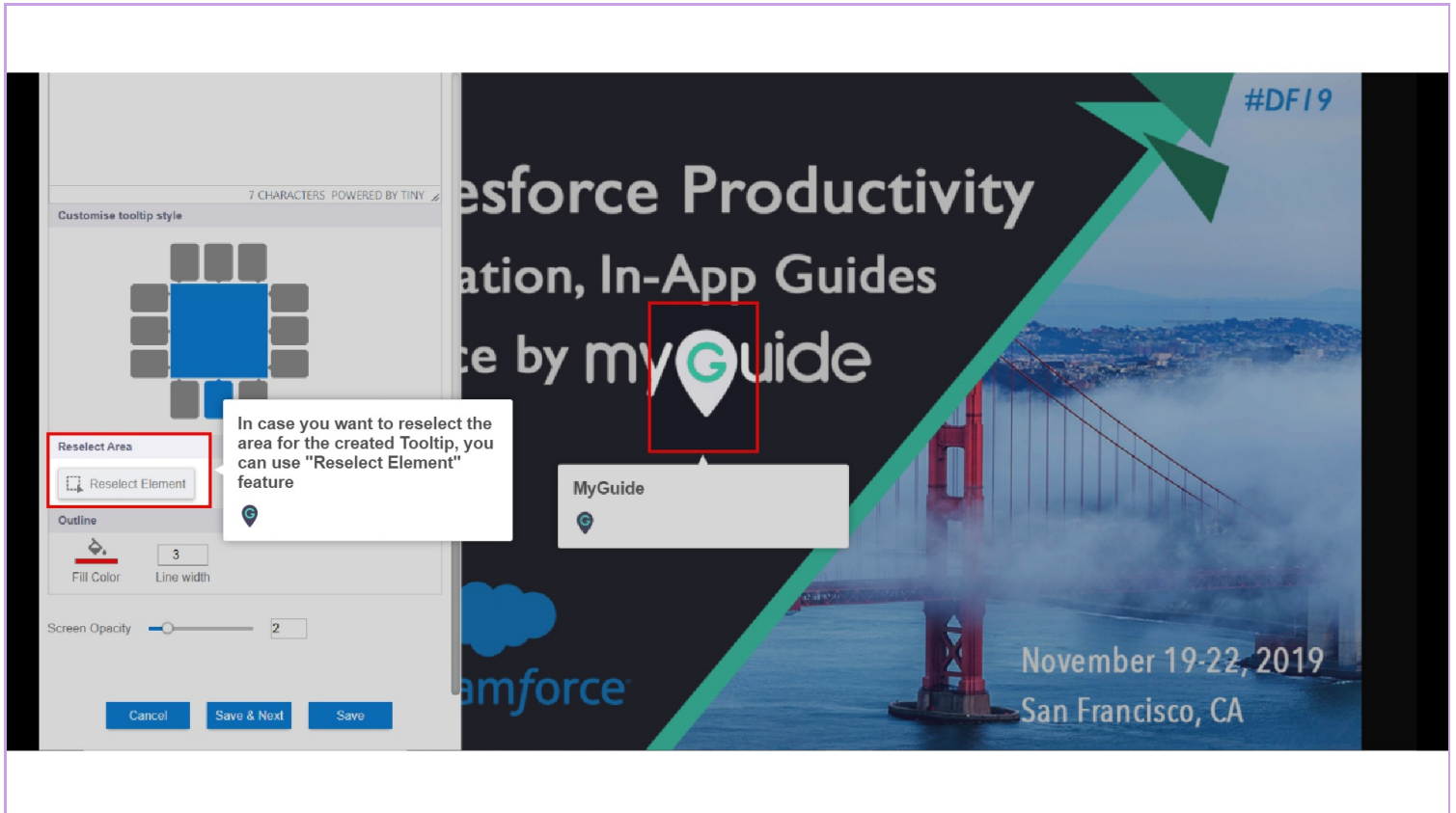
Step: 03

From here, you can choose a position for tooltip



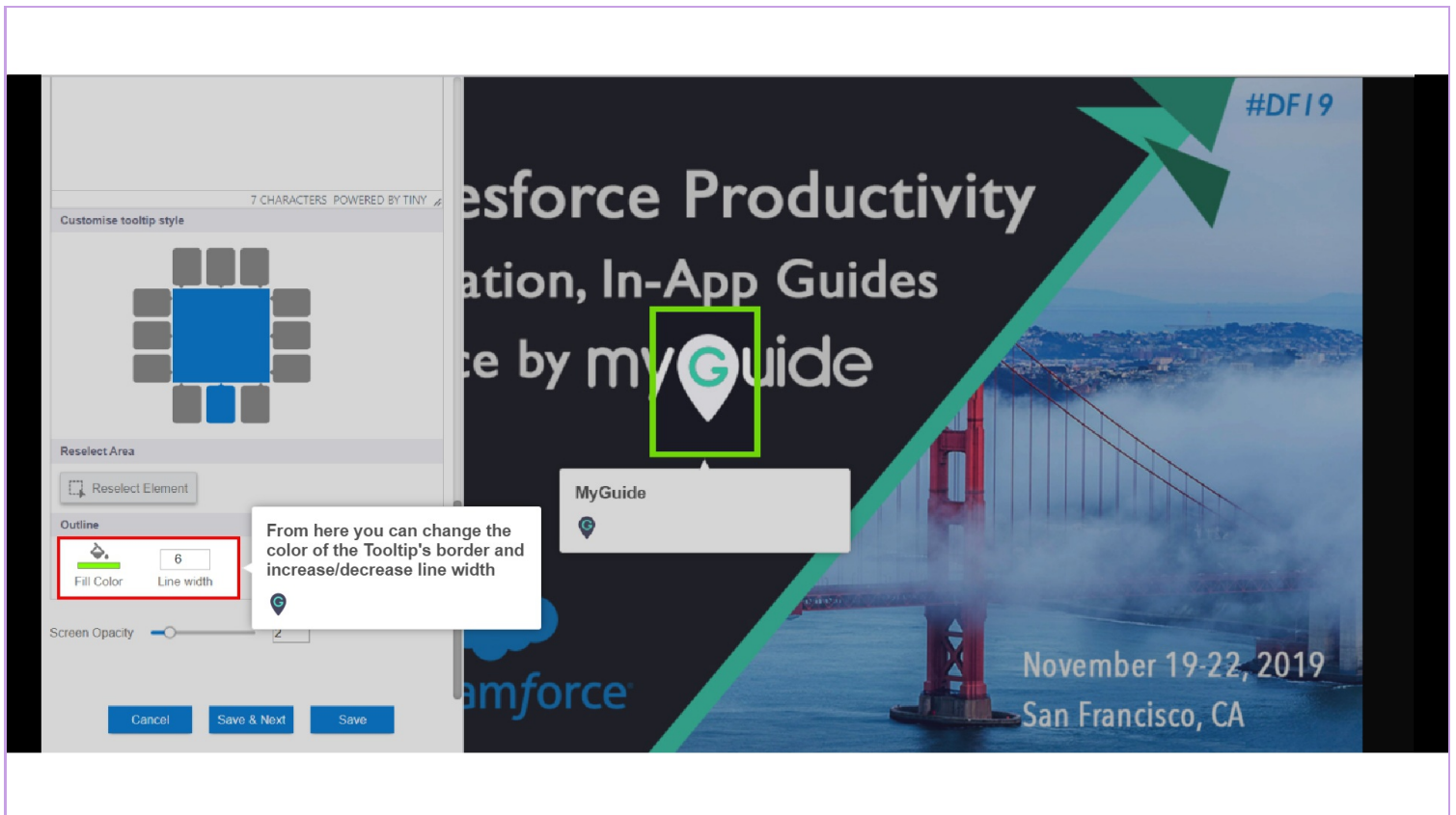
Step: 04
