




Let's Learn About Branch Steps


Step: 01

Click on "Add Step"




Step: 02

Click on "Branch Step"




Step: 03

To rename the branch, just click there and type




Step: 04

You can add a new branch from here




Step: 05

Select a rule from here




Step: 06

Select an operator from here which will satisfy the condition of the URL that was auto-populated




Step: 07

Add a new rule from here




Step: 09


Step: 10

Click the ellipsis to view more options




Step: 11

You can "Edit" or "Delete" Branch Title from here




Step: 12

When you hover over the branch line, "Add Step" option appears, click it




Step: 13
