




Widget Settings


Step: 01

1) Click the navigation menu




Step: 02

1) Click on "Organisation Settings"




Step: 03

Go to "Widget" section




Step: 04

Step: 05


Select a radio button or edit the pixels to set the position of widget icon


Step: 06

When you select show option, you can add rules for the specific URLs where you want the widget to show. If you do not add rules, the widget will appear everywhere




Step: 08
