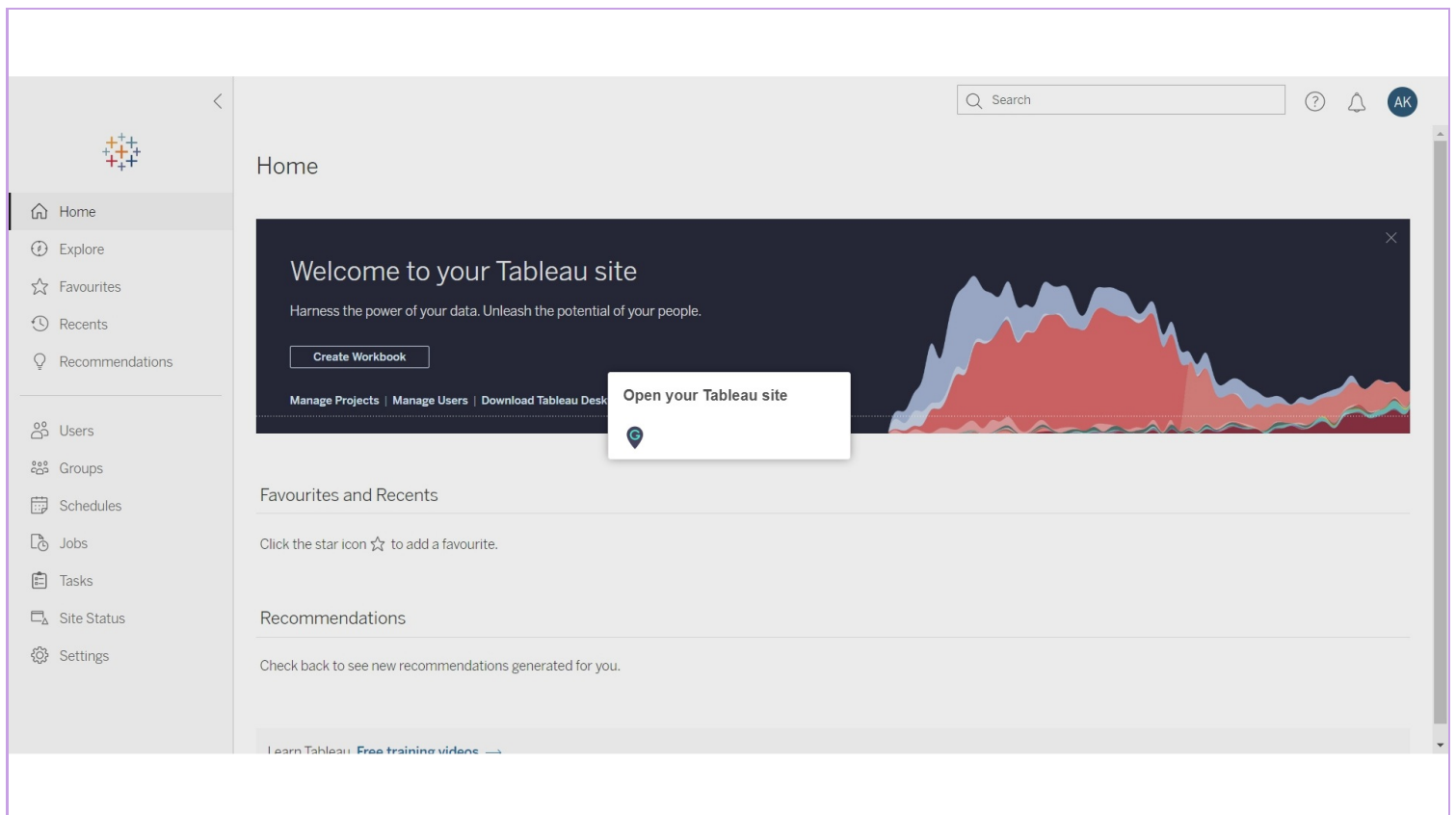




How to enable app lock for Tableau Mobile from
Tableau online


Step: 01

Step: 02


Click on "Settings"

Connected Clients

Tableau clients such as Tableau Mobile, Tableau Bridge and others can stay authenticated to this server after the user provides sign-in credentials the first time. Connections are established using secure tokens that uniquely identify each user and clients, without storing the user's credentials.

App Lock for Tableau Mobile

App lock requires users to open the app with a biometric method or device passcode. App lock is recommended only if the Connected Clients setting is enabled.
